

PRE-APPLICATION PUBLIC CONSULTATION

NEW SECURE CHILDREN'S HOME FOR LONDON

You are invited to a public consultation event to view initial proposals for the redevelopment of part of the Thames Water Depot site on Lea Bridge Road, E5 9HP.

London boroughs are leading on proposals to develop and build a new secure children's home on this site, using funding from the Department for Education.

This residential facility will provide specialist welfare placements for highly vulnerable children with complex needs. Nationally, there is a severe shortage of welfare placements in secure children's homes

and there is no facility of this kind in London. As well as supporting London's most vulnerable children, the proposed provision will help to alleviate serious national capacity issues.

Part of the Thames Water Depot site was identified as the only suitable location for this facility following an assessment of sites across London. The proposals that have been developed are sensitive and respectful of the surrounding area and local context, whilst also meeting the criteria and requirements the new secure children's home.

We are at an early stage of the design development process and are keen to share initial design ideas with the local community for feedback, prior to developing the plans further and before submitting a planning application. An initial public consultation event is going to take place on **Wednesday 7th February** to present the current proposals for community feedback.

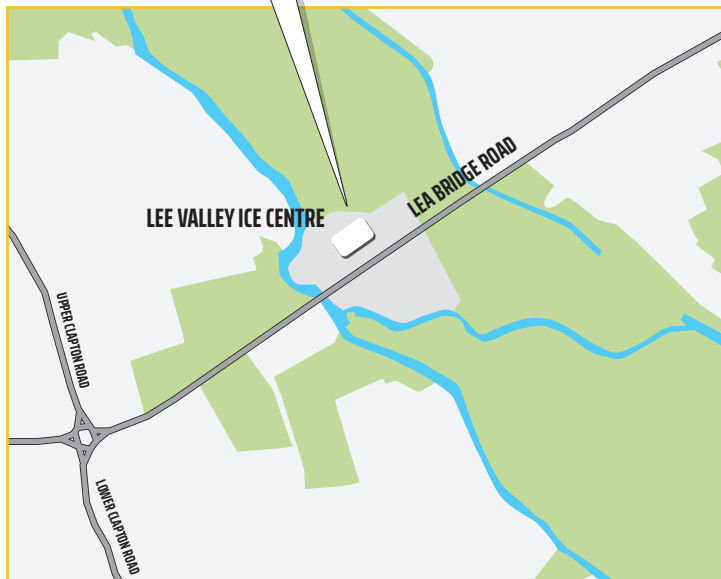
